


Insights allow moderators to mark responses that stand out. Examples for use include a description of why the response was meaningful, or to make a note for other moderators to see.



Start by clicking the Add Insight icon below the participant's reply.

Type in your insight into the box, then select if you want to make your insight public. Public insights are visible to observers as well as moderators. If "Share with Observers" is not selected, the insight will be private and only visible to moderators. When you are finished, click "Save"

After your insight is saved, you can click to edit or delete the insight.
